

The Academy of Medical Sciences is seeking applications for Newton International and Newton Advanced Fellowships.

These fellowships are offered under the [Newton Fund](#), which aims to develop the long term sustainable economic growth and welfare of partner countries through building research and innovation capacity.

**Newton International Fellowships** support early career international researchers from partner countries to undertake research in clinical or patient-oriented research at a host university or research institution in the UK.

Applications are welcome from applicants based in **China, Mexico, India** and **Turkey**.

Fellowships are for two years, and include stipend, research costs, and basic relocation costs. Applicants should have no more than 7 years active full time postdoctoral experience at the time of application.

**The closing date is 9 September 2015.**

**Newton Advanced Fellowships** provide established researchers with an opportunity to develop the research strengths and capabilities of their research group through training, collaboration and reciprocal visits with a partner in the UK. Applications are welcome from applicants based in **China, who hold a Distinguished Young Scholar or Excellent Young Scientist award from the National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC)**.

Awards last for up to three years and are available to support researchers in clinical and patient oriented research. Up to £37,000 is available each year for research support, travel and subsistence, support for training and a salary top up.

Applicants should be within 15 years of their PhD.
